By Public Transportation

The School of Architecture is easily accessible via CTA. Nearby options include the Blue Line train (UIC/Halsted station) and several bus routes: 7 Harrison, 8 Halsted, and 60 Blue Island/26th. The building is approximately one mile from Union Station and Ogilvie Transportation Center, which serve Amtrak and Metra trains.

By Car

The visitor parking lot closest to the School of Architecture is the Halsted/Taylor parking structure at 760 W Taylor St. The School is a 5- to 10-minute walk straight up Halsted St. from that garage. Further information about parking is available at <https://parking.uic.edu/facilities>.

When You Arrive

Enter campus from Harrison Street to access the main entrance to the School. There's a sign on Harrison Street indicating the "Architecture and Design Studios." The building is behind a residence hall. Walk south into the drive toward the School of Architecture. Walk up the steps or ramp to the main entrance of the building.

Getting to the Administrative Offices (suite 1300)

From the main entrance, follow the hallway to your right, down the ramp, to the south lobby of the building. Then turn right into a white inner lobby. The office is through the glass double doors.

Getting to Gallery 1100

From the main entrance, take a wide circle to your right around the large stairway at the main entrance. Gallery 1100 is behind the stairway, through the double doors left of the ramp.

Getting to the Graduate Studio (studio 4100)

From the main entrance, take a wide circle to your right around the large stairway at the main entrance. Walk toward the elevator, which is next to the windows that should be directly in front of you. (Don't go down the ramp!) Take the elevator to the 4th floor, which will bring you directly into the Graduate Studio.
