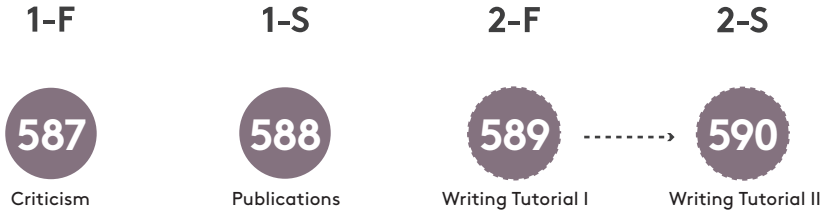


# MAD-Crit Curriculum

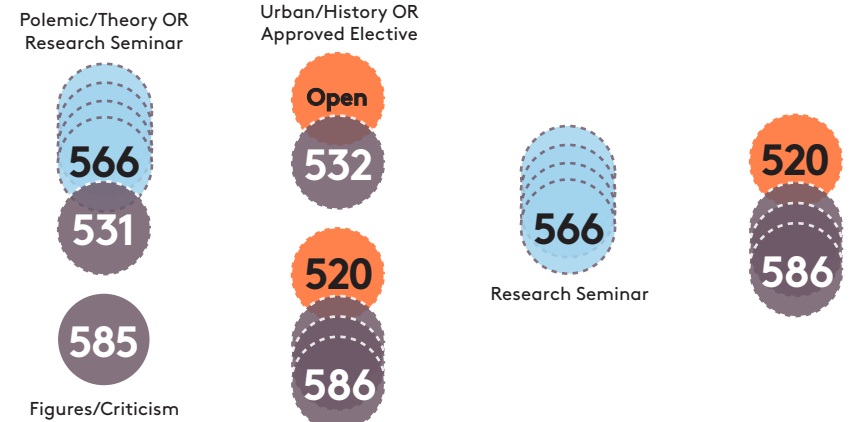
The first year of the MAD-Crit curriculum introduces students to the discipline of architecture and its theory and history through required courses and electives taken with MArch students. Pro-seminars specific to the MAD-Crit program immerse students in a variety of modes of design criticism and the dissemination of architectural ideas.

In the second year, MAD-Crit students take a research seminar with MArch students in the fall and continue with other electives in the fall and spring. They also undertake a year-long independent research and writing project, addressing a topic of their choice across multiple writing genres and for various audiences.

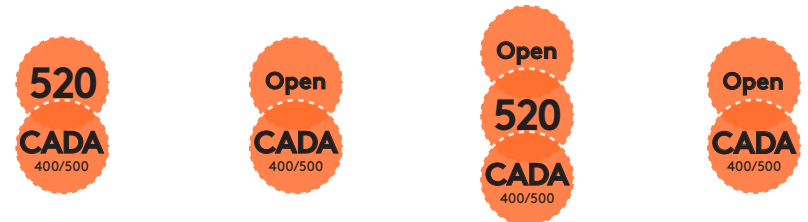
## Pro-Seminars 16 credits
