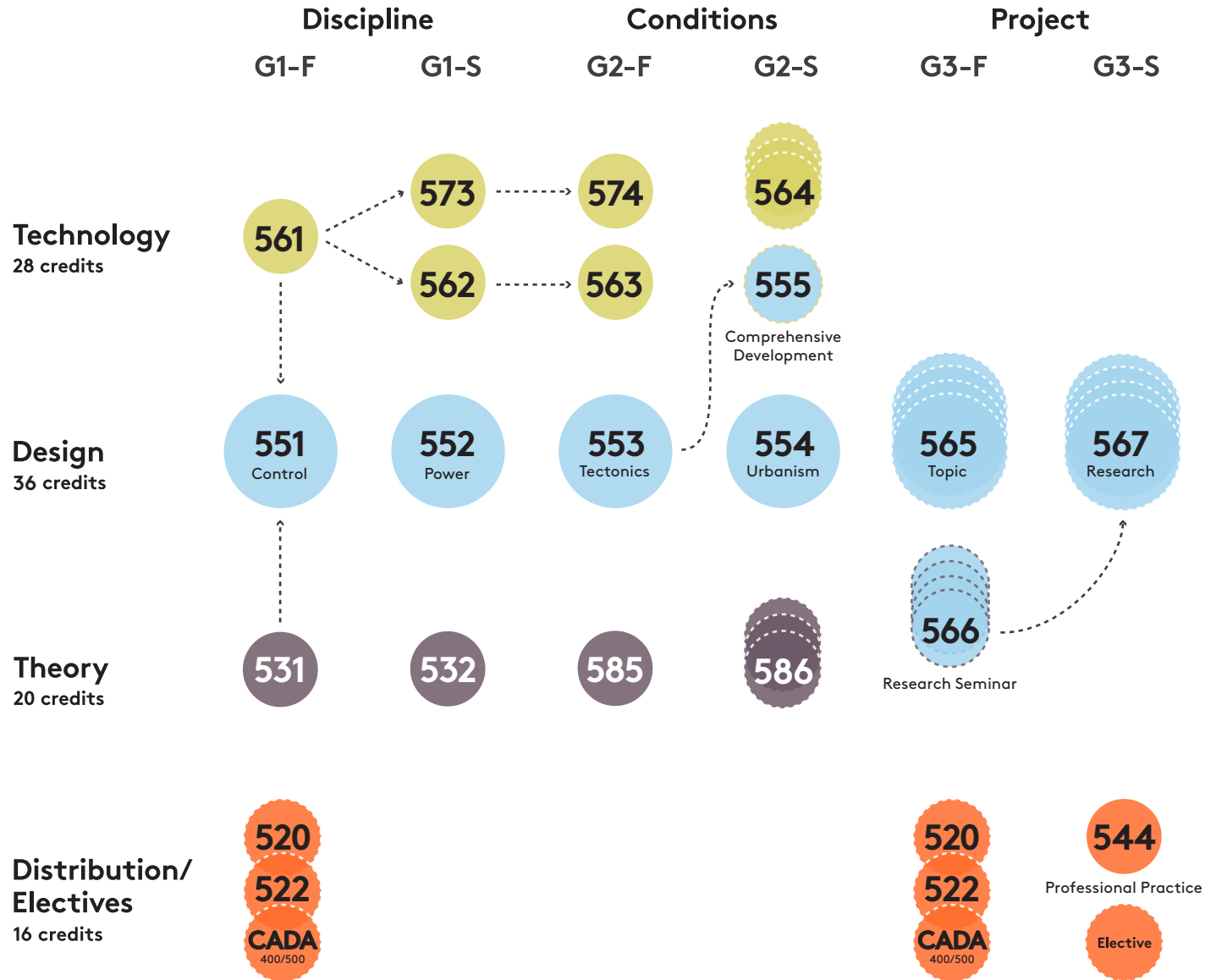


# MArch Curriculum

To receive the MArch degree, students must complete a minimum of one hundred credit hours. In addition to core studio, theory, and technology courses, students are required to take three distribution electives, including one each from Theory + History (Arch 520) and Technology (Arch 522), along with an approved 400/500-level open elective.

Before their first year in the program, MArch students are required to attend a two-week workshop at the end of the summer that introduces them to contemporary methods of production, including software, as well as current debates in the field.



The size of each circle represents the number of credit hours associated with each course. Classes with larger circles are worth more credits.

Dashed outlines indicate courses where students can select from multiple options.
